

Addison Meriwether Weedman

A.M. Weedman was born October 2, 1826 in Breckinridge County, Kentucky between Stephensport and Holt's Bottom, on the river, where, and in Perry County, Indiana, he resided until 1848 when he moved to Meade County, Kentucky and located on the same farm where he now resides.

His father, Stephen Weedman, was born near Leitchfield, Grayson County in 1806. He was a farmer, and for several years, engaged in house carpentering, building flat boats, and other mechanical labor. He was married about 1824 to Miss Mary Gilbert of Breckinridge County. From this union sprang A.M., Amos G., Daniel R., Mordecai, Jacob (deceased), William, Myram, Francis, John (deceased), Martha F. (deceased), and Mollie Brand of Union County.

On October 18, 1851 Mr. Weedman married Miss Louisa, daughter of William and Nancy (Lasley) Brown of Nelson County. To them have been born James E. who emigrated to California in 1876, and in 1885 married Mrs. Rowena Ball of Humboldt County; Elizabeth, Barbara Jane (deceased), William S. (deceased), Sarah E. (Brown), Loulie (Sedoris), Minnie L. (deceased), Martha F. (Singleton), and John B.

Mr. Weedman has become the owner of 152 acres of well improved land, on which he has eight acres of orchard. He is a thoroughly self-made man, a solid farmer, and in politics is a Democrat.
